Camp Facilities

Rock Lake United Church Camp is located on 480 diverse acres of land between Jaffray and Elko in southeastern B.C and is fully accredited by both the United Church of Canada and the British Columbia Camping Association. Situated in a rustic setting with its own private lake, the camp can accommodate up to 45 campers in 7 cabins. Each cabin during the junior camps has a trained Cabin Leader in with them. In addition to the campers' cabins there is a large meeting hall, dining hall, hospital, outdoor chapel, and leaders' cabins. The camp has modern washhouse facilities. A certified lifeguard and spotters always supervise the beach area. The camp has some watercraft available for campers.



Camp Program

Our program includes activities such as crafts, hiking, swimming and water activity, outdoor & indoor games, campfire, singing, Bible study times, and many more special surprise events. All our activities are designed to take advantage of the beautiful Rock Lake Camp setting. Our hope is that the camping experience will develop lasting friendships, appreciation for all that is in nature, and the understanding of God in His world. The program is designed and endorsed by the Rock Lake United Church Camp Society specifically to appeal to the ages of our campers.



Camp Staff

The Rock Lake United Church Camp Society appoints a Director to oversee and manage the camp. In turn, the Director selects fully qualified waterfront personnel, a camp nurse, experienced kitchen staff and other adult leaders as are necessary. In addition, a fully trained cabin leader leads each cabin of up to seven campers.



Cabin Leader Training Program

Rock Lake United Church Camp incorporates a Cabin Leader Training program for mature 14 to 16 year old teenagers with ambitions of being a Cabin Leader at a future camp.
